Baltimore County PASSPORT



1 **Benjamin Banneker Historical Park and Museum**
Park and museum with trails, gardens, and exhibits honoring mathematician, astronomer, and surveyor Benjamin Banneker.

2 **Camp Chapel United Methodist Church**
Historic church that was the site of United Methodist camp meetings between 1776 and 1801.

3 **Diggs-Johnson Museum**
Community-based museum preserving African American history and heritage in Baltimore County.

4 **East Towson Freedom Trail**
Walking trail interpreting the history of one of the oldest free Black communities in Maryland.

5 **The Fire Museum of Maryland**
Museum featuring historic firefighting apparatus and interactive exhibits on Maryland fire service history.

6 **Fort Garrison**
Site of a small frontier fort used during the French and Indian War.

7 **Fort Howard Park**
Former coastal defense fort later used as a military hospital; now a waterfront park with historic remnants.

8 **Glenn L. Martin Maryland Aviation Museum**
Museum at Martin State Airport preserving Maryland's aviation history and the legacy of the Glenn L. Martin Company.

9 **Hampton National Historic Site**
One of the nation's largest historic estates, built by the Ridgely family in the late 18th century and preserved by the National Park Service.

10 **Heritage Society of Essex and Middle River**
Local history museum preserving the maritime, industrial, and community heritage of Essex and Middle River.

11 **Historical Society of Baltimore County**
Research library, museum, and archives preserving Baltimore County's documentary and genealogical history.

12 **Hubert V. Simmons Museum of Negro Leagues Baseball**
Museum preserving the history and legacy of Negro Leagues baseball and Maryland's contributions to the sport.

13 **Jericho Covered Bridge**
Built in 1865 as a cooperative effort between Baltimore and Harford Counties and one of the last remaining covered bridges in the region.

14 **Lake Roland**
Historic reservoir established in 1861 to supply Baltimore's water. Now a park with Civil War-era rail history, trails, and nature programming.

15 **Marshy Point Nature Center**
Waterfront nature center with exhibits and trails highlighting Chesapeake Bay ecology and maritime heritage.

16 **Mount Gilboa Chapel**
The Mount Gilboa Chapel, originally built in 1799 and replaced with the current stone structure in 1859, is the oldest among the 31 historically African American churches in Baltimore County.

17 **Manor Mill**
Restored 18th-century grist mill now serving as a community arts and cultural center.

18 **Natural History Society of Maryland**
Now in its 97th year, the museum offers a natural history exhibit, family-friendly programming, lectures, and workshops.

19 **Oregon Ridge Park**
Former iron ore mining site turned park and nature center, highlighting Civil War-era industrial history.

20 **Perry Hall Mansion***
The oldest standing and one of the last remaining colonial homes in Baltimore County.

21 **Pikesville Armory**
The second oldest armory in Maryland—significant for training units that played a key role in D-Day.

22 **Reisterstown Heritage Walking Trail**
Self-guided walking trail interpreting 18th- and 19th-century architecture and the founding of Reisterstown.

23 **Thomas Viaduct**
The oldest multi-arched stone railroad bridge in the United States, completed in 1835 for the B&O Railroad.

24 **Todd's Inheritance**
18th-century farmhouse associated with the War of 1812 and preserved as a community museum.

25 **Towson Walking Tour**
Self-guided tour highlighting Towson's evolution from 18th-century village to County seat.

26 **Turner Station History Center**
Community history center preserving the story of Turner Station, a significant African American industrial community tied to Bethlehem Steel.
